MEMO TO: 4-H Advisor and FFA Sponsors or Ag Science Teachers

SUBJECT: Freestone County Fair and Rodeo Calf Scramble

Enclosed is information pertaining to the 2023 scramble.

Being in a leadership position, you are aware of the time and money involved in a project animal. Fairfield, Teague, Wortham, and 4H; we ask that each of you select 6 members in your program to participate in the calf scramble making a total of 24 with 12 participating each night with 6 calves as winners. Please advise your members of the additional money that is needed to carry out a project animal as in feed, cost of animal, and facilities to house the animal. Please make sure your members understand the huge responsibility and amount of time involved in this project. Each recipient will initially receive a \$500 certificate to go towards the purchase of a project animal of any species (i.e. – beef heifer or steer, swine, sheep, goat, chicken, or rabbit).

<u>Note:</u> The calf scramble is for 14, 15, 16, and 17 age individuals due to insurance requirements. Individuals must be 14 years of age before beginning date of the Freestone County Fair and Rodeo, June 12, 2023.

It is important as 4H Advisors and Ag Science Teachers that you understand the scramble, how it works, and what is expected from the participants.

*All entries must be submitted by 4H Advisor or Ag Science Teachers by the May 26, 2023 FCFA entry deadline to Michelle Welch.

Fairfield -6, Wortham -6, Teague -6, and 4H-6. Total -24 with 12 participating each night for 6 calves which will already be haltered.

Enclosed are all the papers needed to enter the calf scramble.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

AGE: 14 thru 17 years (June 12, 2023 will be the age determination date)

Scramblers will be chosen by the FFA sponsors and 4H Advisor.

Winners of the 2023 Freestone County Fair and Rodeo Calf Scramble Contest will receive a certificate toward the purchase of the animal species of their choice.

- 1. The Freestone County Fair Association will not be responsible for any accidents which may occur to any participant in the Calf Scramble, before, during, or after the scramble.
- Incomplete minors' releases will not be accepted. All information requested on the minor's
 release must be complete. Parent or legal guardian must sign the release. The release
 must be notarized. Your final 6 completed minors' releases, entry forms, and responsibilities
 sheets must be submitted by 4H Advisor and Ag Science Teachers on the May 26, 2023 FCFA
 entry deadline to Michelle Welch
- 3. Projects must be declared on entry form to be eligible for scramble.
- 4. Exhibitors are restricted to Freestone County.
- 5. A contestant must have reached their 14th, but not their 18th birthday, by or on June 12, 2023 and cannot exceed their junior year in high school.

ARENA RULES

- 1. Participants will take nothing into the rodeo arena with them. Halter will be on the 6 calves when they are released into the arena. (It is suggested that the supervisors of all participants instruct them on how to encourage the calf to lead or back using the halter.)
- 2. At no time will a participant be permitted to tie the rope to his/her body or belt.
- 3. Each participant will attempt to catch one of the calves released. The participant catching a calf is required to lead or back it across the finish line without aid.
- 4. If a participant has hold of a calf, no other participant will be allowed to touch the calf until it breaks away.
- 5. If two or more participants catch the same calf, the first participant to touch the calf keeps possession to try and cross the line.
- 6. A participant who secures and properly leads it across the finish line will be declared a winner when so indicated by the referee.
- 7. Undue roughness will not be tolerated. Poor sportsmanship automatically disqualifies scrambler

PURCHASING RULES

- 1. Certificates may be used to purchase a steer, heifer, pig, goat, or lamb.
- 2. All animals purchased must be purchased according to the Freestone County Fair Association rules and regulations.
- 3. Scramble winner must select the animal they desire to purchase and present certificate.

 NOTE: All information must be filled out by seller, along with the signature of Ag-Science
 Teachers or the 4H Advisor. The Freestone County Fair Association payment will not exceed
 the amount of the certificate. If animal purchased is more than the Freestone County Fair
 Association certificate, additional cost will be the winner's expense.
- 4. Winners cannot purchase animals from themselves or immediate family members or their ranches (family ranches or partnerships). Winners may not purchase animals that have been previously exhibited through any Calf Scramble program. Checks will not be issued to 4-H clubs, FFA Chapters, students, parents, or supervisors.
- 5. Winner must use certificate to purchase their project animal. Steer, heifer, lamb, goat, chicken, or rabbit must be purchased by the FCFA county validation dates for the 202Freestone County Fair Association Livestock Show and Sale.
- 6. <u>Market animal projects may not be entered in any show prior to the Freestone County Fair Livestock Show that requires the winning animals to be sold at auction.</u>

Turn in your applications to your Ag Science Teachers or 4H Advisor

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Winners must write a minimum of four (4) to six (6) letters to their sponsors including pictures of their project animals. However, it is strongly encouraged that additional letters and pictures be sent to their sponsor. Copies of all letters must be sent to the Ag Science Teachers or 4H Advisor.
 - a. A "thank you" letter must be sent within ten (10) days from the date of the Calf Scramble;
 - b. A "purchase" letter must be sent within ten (10) days of purchasing the project animal;
 - c. A letter updating their sponsor on their project animal and requesting their attendance at the livestock show; and
 - d. A final letter advising their sponsor of how the animal placed at the show and how it did at the sale.
- 2. Read all communication, abiding with all rules set by the Freestone County Fair Association
- 3. Type a <u>500-word essay</u> entitled <u>"MY CALF SCRAMBLE PROJECT"</u> to be <u>turned in by teachers</u> or advisor at the FCFA Fair entry deadline date 2024.
- 4. <u>Keep record book of project.</u> Record books are <u>to be turned in to teachers or advisor at by</u> first day of the FCFA Fair 2024.

- 5. Produce a Scrapbook for display in the Home and Garden Building during the fair week.
- 6. Winners must exhibit their project animal at the 2024 Freestone County Fair Livestock Show, unless circumstances approved by the FCFA Board of Directors, and their supervisor make this impractical. All project animals are subject to the rules and regulations of the Freestone County Fair Association Livestock Rules.
 - **a.** You are required to display a sign by your project at the Freestone County Fair Association Livestock Show saying your project was sponsored by the sponsor of the night of your calf scramble (My project was sponsored by _____ during the 2023 Freestone County Fair and Rodeo Calf Scramble.)
- 7. The Ag Science Teachers or 4H Advisor will be making periodic project visits. If a visit is made and the animal is found to be in poor health, the advisors or 4H sponsor reserves the right to take appropriate action to make sure the animal begins to receive proper care. The Freestone County Fair Association also reserves the right to not allow a participant to scramble in the future if their animal is not being properly cared for.
